Annual Series

Medal & Record Representation Policy

1. Purpose & Scope

This policy governs **medal badges, record designations, and performance statistics** displayed exclusively on **Peace in Pressure (PIP) Annual Series trading cards**.

Peace in Pressure may release additional card series (including special editions, invitational series, or experimental formats). Such series may follow **different representation rules** and are **not governed by this policy unless explicitly stated**.

2. Governing Bodies Recognized

For the **PIP Annual Series**, medal and record eligibility is limited to achievements officially recognized by at least one internationally sanctioned freediving governing body:

- **AIDA**
- **CMAS**

Peace in Pressure respects the **independent rules, judging standards, and validation processes** of both organizations.

3. Unified Medal Badging System

PIP utilizes a **unified, federation-neutral approach** that honors the **achievement itself**, rather than the governing body under which it was recognized.

A. World Record (WR) Badge

A single **World Record (WR)** medal badge may be displayed if a performance has been officially ratified as a World Record by **AIDA, CMAS, or both**.

Historical Recognition (WR Only)

Unique to the World Record tier, a WR badge may be displayed if the athlete **officially held the World Record at any point during the applicable Annual Series year**, provided the record was ratified prior to the Production Cut-off Date.

Legacy Status

A World Record that is later surpassed or broken within the same Annual Series year **does not invalidate** the WR badge for that athlete's card.

Federation Neutrality

The WR badge does not specify the governing body and does not display federation branding.

B. Other Medal Categories (Current Status Standard)

The same unified, federation-neutral approach applies to:

- National Records (NR)
- Continental Records (CR)
- Official Championship Podium Finishes

Status at Cut-off

For these categories, badges reflect the athlete's **official status as of the Production Cut-off Date**.

If a National or Continental record is lost prior to the cut-off date, the corresponding badge will **not** be displayed.

Future Reservation of Rights

Peace in Pressure reserves the right to apply the **Historical Recognition / Legacy Status** logic to National and Continental records in future Annual Series editions. Any such change will be clearly disclosed at the time of release.

4. Stats & Performance Representation

- **Official Results:** Depths, disciplines, and statistics reflect results officially recognized by AIDA or CMAS
- **Clean Design:** Federation names, logos, or parallel records are not displayed
- **Date of Record:** The “Date of Record” reflects the date the performance occurred, regardless of administrative ratification timing
- **No Double-Counting:** Identical achievements recognized by both organizations are counted once

All statistics represent a **snapshot of verified achievements as of the Production Cut-off Date** and are not intended to reflect real-time rankings or current personal bests.

5. Eligibility & Verification

All Annual Series medals and records must meet the following verification standards:

- **Official Sanctioning:** Ratified by AIDA or CMAS
- **Rule Compliance:** Meets applicable judging and safety protocols
- **Public Record:** Supported by verifiable documentation

Federation details may be reviewed internally but are not displayed on the card.

6. Exclusions

The following do **not** qualify for unified medal or record badges in the Annual Series:

- Training dives or personal bests outside official competition
- Unsanctioned events
- Pending, disputed, or unratified claims
- Achievements recognized by organizations other than AIDA or CMAS

Such achievements may appear as **non-medal highlights** at PIP's discretion and will be **visually distinguished** from official badges.

7. Production Cut-off & Final Authority

Data Freeze

All card data is subject to a **Production Cut-off Date** established for each Annual Series (e.g., December 31 at 11:59 PM local time).

Finality

Peace in Pressure retains final discretion over all medal eligibility, badge usage, and stat presentation.

Retroactive Changes

Once printed, Peace in Pressure is **not obligated to modify, recall, or reprint** physical cards if a governing body later nullifies, alters, or reverses an achievement.
